MFS extends condolence to Jewish community

Multi-Faith Saskatchewan (MF-SK) denounces the devastating attack on the Tree of Life synagogue in Pittsburgh (Pennsylvania) and extends its deepest condolences to our Jewish brothers and sisters in Regina and Saskatoon and in other parts of Saskatchewan after this horrific crime. We condemn this heinous and cowardly attack on a house of worship. We grieve for those who were murdered in Pittsburgh on Shabbat morning at synagogue. Such an act of terror affects all of us. MF-SK condemns anti-Semitism, bigotry, and hate in all its forms. Law enforcement officers in the United States are rightfully investigating the incident as an anti-Semitic hate crime.

This was an attack not just on the Jewish community, but on all of us in Saskatchewan. Our hearts break for the families of those killed and injured at the Tree of Life Synagogue, and for the entire Jewish community. We invite everyone to pray for the families impacted. We simply cannot accept this violence as a normal part of our life in North America, this should just not be happening.

Hateful acts that take place in places of worship are just unthinkable and must be condemned with the utmost vigor. Every individual has the right to attend his house of worship in safety. MR-SK reaffirms its commitment to working with all faith-based communities to find tangible solutions to the rising intolerance in our society. We stand in solidarity with you through this time and welcome any requests you may have of us as you move through these challenging days
